Hours of Operation: Monday-Friday, 6:00am - 6:00pm

Buses depart from the Cortland County Office Building on 60 Central Ave. Buses utilize flag stops. Signal the driver to stop by flagging (waving) your hand to alert the driver to stop for pickup.


Routes 1-4 Operate on 45-minute Intervals

Buses leave the County Office Building at 6:00am, 6:45am, 7:30am, 8:15am, 9:00am, 9:45am, 10:30am, 11:15am, 12:00pm, 12:45pm, 1:30pm, 2:15pm, 3:00pm, 3:45pm, 4:30pm, and 5:15pm. Travelers can estimate time bus will come to desired stop within these 45-minute intervals.

Route 7	\$5.00	(reduced fare \$2.50)

Fare must be paid in exact change, drivers cannot make change. Children five years old and younger ride free and must be accompanied by a responsible adult (up to three children per adult).



REDUCED FARES

HALF-FARE FOR SENIOR CITIZENS, MEDICARE CARDHOLDERS, PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES AND YOUTH UNDER 18

Persons 60 years old or older, medicare cardholders, youth under 18 years of age, persons with a disability and those currently receiving SSI, SSD, or disabled veterans benefits are eligible to pay half-fare on Cortland Transit bus. The bus operator may ask for proof of eligibility. Acceptable forms of proof of eligibility are your Medicare card, Senior Citizen's Discount Card, drivers license, or half-fare identification card. To obtain a card, please call Cortland Transit at 607-758-3383.

TRANSFERS


Riders are allowed to transfer for free to any bus, except Route 7. However, riders can transfer from Route 7 for free. Please notify the bus driver to request a transfer.



DIAL-A-RIDE SERVICE

Dial-A-Ride is a curb-to-curb transportation service operated by Cortland Transit. Residents wishing to access the service must schedule a ride at least 1 business day in advance. Fares are a minimum of \$5 and a maximum of \$6, one way. Please call if you need to cancel a ride. If you are late by more than 3 minutes, the driver will leave. Reduced fares apply with half-fare card. To schedule or cancel a Dial-A-Ride, please call Cortland Transit at 607-758-3383.

FLEX ROUTES (ROUTES 8-13)

Flex routes run twice per day. Please visit our website at way2gocortland.org for maps and schedules.

MONTHLY PASSES

Monthly Passes are available for purchase at Cortland Transit offices, Access to Independence, Catholic Charities, P&C Fresh, Grand Union, SUNY Cortland Campus Bookstore and Tompkins Cortland Community College. The monthly bus pass must be shown on each ride and remain in your possession for the entire trip.

ROUTE DEVIATION

Deviations are within 3/4 mile of the route and available on all routes by notifying the driver when boarding the bus. It applies to full-fare and half-fare riders. The fee for a deviation is the same as the fare for the ride.

Deviation example, \$1.50 standard fare + \$1.50 deviation = \$3.00 total Deviation example, \$0.75 half-fare + \$0.75 deviation = \$1.50 total


