# Cortland Transit

## Hours of Operation: M-F, 6 am - 6 pm

Buses depart from the County Office Building on Central Ave. Buses utilize flag stops; signal the driver with your hand to stop the bus for a pickup.

Routes 1 - 4	\$1.50	(reduced fare \$0.75)
Routes 5, 6, 8-15	\$2.00	(reduced fare \$1.00)
Route 7	\$5.00	(reduced fare \$2.50)
Monthly pass (all but Rte. 7)	\$45.00	(reduced fare applies)
Monthly pass (incl. Rte. 7)	\$85.00	

Fare must be paid in exact change, drivers cannot make change. Children under the age of 5 ride free with adult; limit 3 per adult.

Routes 1-4 run on 45-minute intervals. Buses leave the County Office Building at 6 am, 6:45 am, 7:30 am, 8:15 am, 9 am, 9:45am, 10:30 am, 11:15 am, 12 noon, 12:45 pm, 1:30pm, 2:15 pm, 3 pm, 3:45 pm, 4:30 pm, and 5:15 pm. Travelers can estimate time bus will come to desired stop within the confines of these 45-minute intervals.

## REDUCED FARES

### PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

Persons with disabilities may be entitled to a fare discount on fixed routes. To receive your discount, you must display a Half-Fare Card each time you board the bus. To obtain a card, please call (607) 758-3383. You will need to provide proof of SSI/SSD, or a copy of Veterans Affairs Benefits for veterans with disabilities. All buses are wheelchair accessible.

### SENIOR CITIZENS

If you are 60 years of age or older you can ride half fare on fixed routes. To receive a discount, you must display a half-fare card or a photo ID with your birth date each time you board.

**Youth** - Under 18 years of age - Eligible for reduced fare

## DIAL-A-RIDE

Cortland Transit operates a Dial-a-Ride system, a curb-to-curb service. Residents wishing to access the service must call (607) 758-3383 at least 2 days in advance. Fares are a minimum of \$5 and a maximum of \$6, one way. Please call if you need to cancel a ride. If you are late by more than 3 minutes, the driver will continue on so other riders will not have to

wait. Reduced fares apply with half-fare card.

## FLEX ROUTES (ROUTES 8-15)

Flex routes run twice per day. Call Cortland Transit (607) 758-3383 for maps and schedules.

## MONTHLY PASSES

Monthly Passes, available at Cortland Transit offices, Access to Independence, Catholic Charities, P&C, and SUNY Cortland Campus Bookstore, must be displayed each ride and remain in your possession for the entire trip.

## ROUTE DEVIATION

Deviations (within 3/4 mile of the route) are available on all routes but only available on runs leaving at the top of the hour on Routes 1-4.

- The charge for a deviation is double the regular fare.
- Deviation charge applies to monthly pass users.

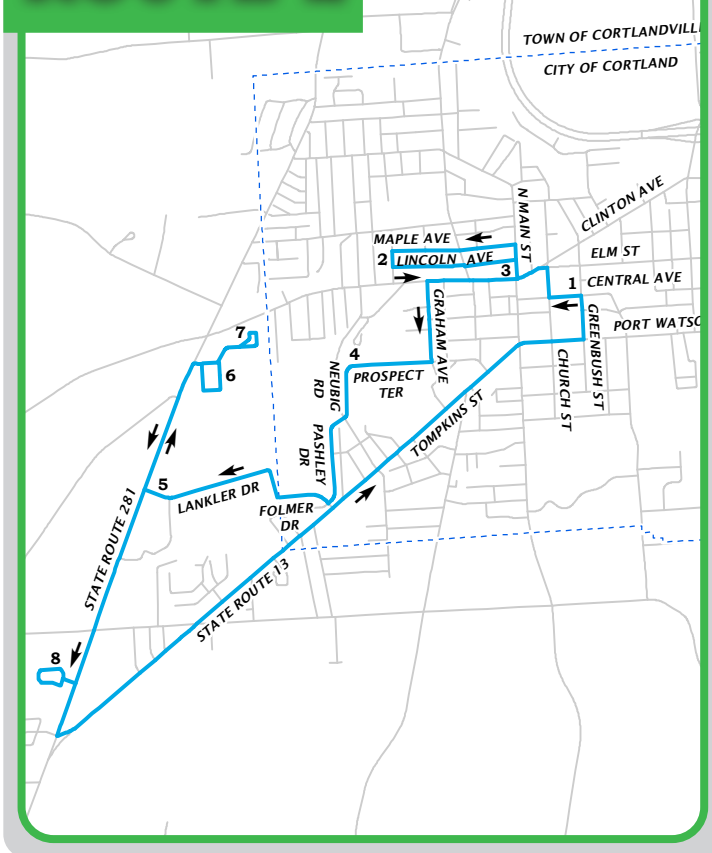

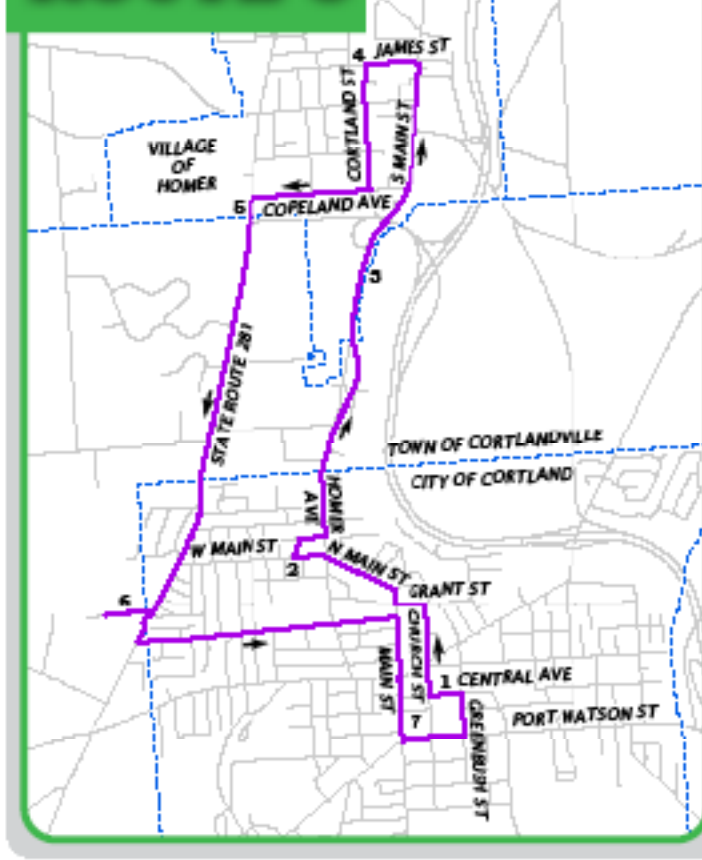




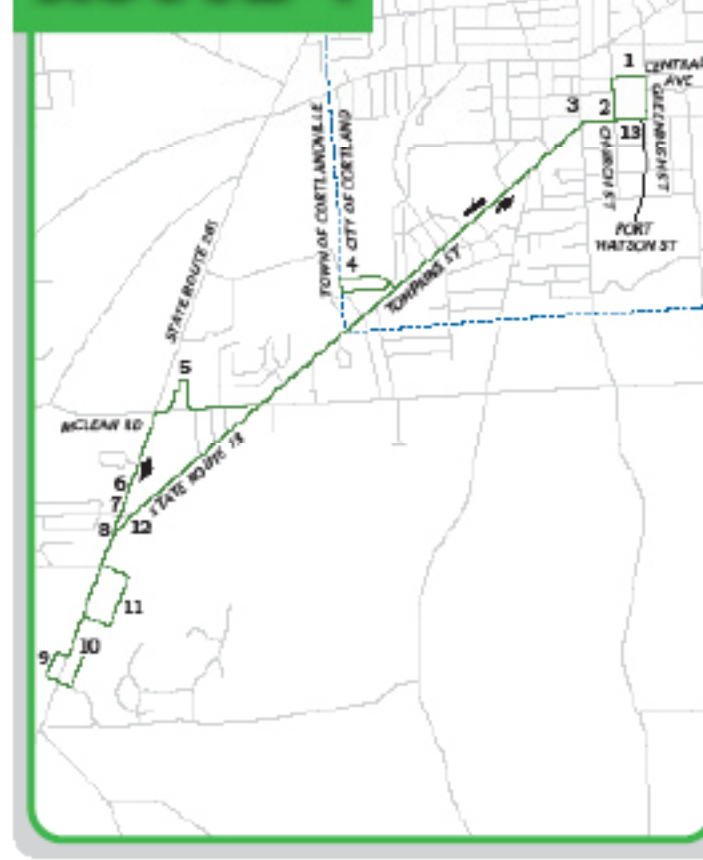
